

What school do you attend?






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Level of Satisfaction

How would you rate your level of satisfaction to date on the following:




- **Teacher Communication:**

100 responses




If no:

"The most positive part has been the planning and the execution of the plan. The communication has been excellent. This is a first for everyone but I think Monomoy has done an excellent job."

What has been the most challenging part of the start of this school year?

- Not seeing friends in other classes
- No sports
- Remote days and computer/Chromebook issues/connectivity/internet
- Masks
- Figuring out how to adapt to online learning
- Workload/screentime

"Unnecessary seminar class that has been very stressful. Lack of guidance and help with support for college applications. We get vague emails with video tutorials. It has been very difficult to fill out the common app. There is no central place where ALL of my college application duties are listed. It is very difficult to keep track of what needs to be done and when



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and without being able to go see guidance when I need to it's nearly impossible. This so far has been the most stressful start to a school year I have had. It would be helpful if our guidance counselors email us personally with things we need to be doing rather than things posted from multiple people on multiple Google classrooms. It would also help if our guidance counselors had weekly open office hours for seniors on Google meet so we can "drop in" with questions in real time rather than waiting for emails back and forth."

"Not having a bus orientation for kindergarteners. Unless I was not told about one, there should have been a bus safety day for all students, especially kindergarteners during the first week of school."

"Getting comfortable with speaking up during lessons / asking for help."

"The most challenging part of this year is not being able to talk to any friends if they aren't in your class."

"It's just a ton of work and the distance learning class is assigning a bunch of homework as well."

"Having my classmates actually follow the safety protocols."

"There's a lot more emails than necessary and chrome books are barely suitable for simple tasks, especially with google meet on in a background tab. If you have class work to do while you're online, you have to wait until after school to do it along with your homework because google meets completely slows everything down. It is mandatory to be virtually present unless excused by teacher, so it's very tedious."

"I still get the same amount of homework as I have in previous years and some teachers don't understand how draining completing hours of homework online after school can be."

"If you could find a way to allow classes to see each other during fresh air time so I can talk to my friends. None of my friends are in my class."



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“Way too much time spent during the 80 minute distance learning classes without letting them do their 'homework'. Too much unnecessary screen time leads to boredom & lack of attention.”

“I hope we stay with having no homework it is better on the kids to have none.”
